Abstract Submission Requirements:

The title of article and the name of the author/s should be written in Arial, size 12, Bold, Capitals, Centered. The affiliation, organization and e-mails of author/s should be written under the author/s name in Arial, size 12, Bold, Center. Structure of the abstract (300 words): problem statement, methods, results and conclusions (brief description), key words (3-5 words which are descriptive of the paper's content and areas) and reference list. All abstracts with key words and reference lists meeting the layout requirements will be included in CD "Programme and Abstracts of II ISC on OT '19".
