MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS TO PAPER LAYOUT

A sample paper is available on the WEB site of the conference - <https://conf.uni-ruse.bg/en>

- Font – **Times New Roman (Word XP or next versions)**.
- Page Setup - Top: **20 mm**, Bottom: **10 mm**, Left: **20 mm**, Right: **20 mm**.
- Paper Size - **A4**.
- Line spacing - Format, Paragraph, Line spacing: **Single**.
- Indentation - Format, Paragraph, Special: **First Line**, By: **1 cm**.
- Header – as in the sample paper.
- Leave one blank line under the Header of the first page - Font Size **14**.
- Title - Font Size **14**, centered, **Bold**.
- One blank line.
- First name and surname of author(s) with rank and degree, work place, telephone, e-mail - Font Size 12, Aligned left.
- One blank line.
- Abstract –in English, Font Size **10**, Italic, up to 1000 characters.
- Key words –in English, Font Size **10**, Italic, 1-2 lines.
- One blank line.
- Paper text - Font Size **12**.
- The sections of the papers are: **INTRODUCTION, EXPOSITION, CONCLUSION and REFERENCES**. If necessary, subheadings are at the discretion of the author, as shown in the sample paper.
- Figures should be made with a widely used software, integrated in the text and numbered; the caption should be below the figure, centered.
- Tables should be numbered, with caption above them, aligned left.
- Formulas should be numbered – numbers in brackets, aligned right.
- In-text citations should follow Harvard system – “author, date” style (e.g. Webster, 2005).
- References should be arranged alphabetically, by surname of first author, standard description. For resources in Cyrillic use BGN/PCGN 2013 for transliteration.
- Pages should not be numbered.
- Footer – as in the sample paper.
- Total volume - 6 pages, incl. abstract.

The original of the paper should be sent to the contact person by e-mail in **DOCX and PDF** format.

PUBLISHING OF PAPERS

All abstracts with keywords and reference lists in English, approved for presentation at the conference and meeting the layout requirements will be included in the **“Proceedings - Programme and abstracts of the 65th ISC of the University of Ruse’26”**. Following their presentation and nomination by the Programme Committee, up to two papers in English from each section will be published in **Compiled works „Best Paper’26”**, which is published as hard copy and on-line on the Conference Website.

All the remaining papers, successfully approved by international double-blind reviewing, will be published in the respective series of **Proceedings of the University of Ruse**, vol. **65, 2026** and on-line on the Conference Website.

DEADLINES

- by 30.08.2026 – an abstract and paper sent by e-mail to the contact person;
- by 10.09.2026 – decision of the Organisation Committee after reviewing sent;
- by 15.09.2026 – final version of the paper sent for presentation in the section;
- by 30.09.2026 – hotel reservation -tel.: 082/822 042 or in student hostel - tel.: 082/845 938;
- by 30.11.2026 – final version of papers sent by authors for publishing in the respective version;
- by 31.12.2026 – publishing of Compiled works “Best Paper”(on paper and on-line);
- by 31.01.2026 – compiled works of the series in vol. 64 of ISC’23 on the Conference Website;
- by 28.02.2027 – invited papers published in journals, recommended by ISC’23, in compliance with their requirement for publishing.

PARTICIPATION FEE

- for all participants – **€ 100**;
- for participants, members of **UNION OF SCIENTISTS RUSE** - **€ 70**.



The fee is for one paper. It includes **"Proceedings - Programme of the 65th ISC of the University of Ruse'26"**, ticket for the Scientists Gala, coffee breaks and **„Best Paper'26"** (nominated after the end of the conference).
